

LuxNUL 6 – SUNSET URBAN EVENT BERTRANGE WEDNESDAY 6 APRIL 2022

The last event in the 2021/22 LuxNUL Luxembourg Night Urban League series	
Meet at	<p>The park across rue Luxembourg from the church, in the centre of Bertrange, on the SW side of the rue Atert car park. Look for the LuxOC beach flag.</p> <p>Parking – adjacent.</p> <p>Public transport – City Bus 6 (comes from Kirchberg), at 18.21, 18.36, 18.51, or 19.07 from the “Hamelius quai 2” stop, or City Bus 5, at 18.15, 18.30, 18.45, or 19.00 from the “Monterey Quai 2” stop near the “Hamilius” tram stop. (Any resemblance between the timetables and when the bus actually comes is purely coincidental.) Stay on either bus until it terminates, both at the “Bertrange, Gemeng Quai 1” stop, about a 20-minute ride (Bus 6 goes via the City Concorde shopping centre, Bus 5 is more direct).</p> <p>Or Train (Line 50 to/from Kleinbettingen/Arlon) to Bertrange-Strassen, at 18.22, 18.32, or 18.52 from Luxembourg Gare – a 6-minute ride. Go under the subway, and walk south for 150 metres along rue de la Gare, then turn right along rue de Luxembourg for about 600 metres.</p>
Facilities	None at all. The event will be outdoors, based on a park bench, or a parked car if wet.
Start times	18.45 until 19.30 or so. Controls will be removed from 20.30.
Entries	No fee – but please try to tell orienteer@orienteering.lu at least a day in advance if you are coming, so we can print the right number of maps and have you ready set up in the SI timing system.
Start point	Start and finish are both within 100 metres of the meeting point.
Format	<p>Two courses</p> <p>Rabbit 3.0 km – medium, minimal climb</p> <p>Deer 5.1 km – longer, minimal climb</p> <p>Straight line distances given – optimum routes are +/- 50% longer.</p> <p>Flags are 15cm kites – “punching” using SPORTident (SIAC enabled). Bring your SI “dibber” if you have one, but if not, you can easily borrow one of the Club’s. Results will be published, and will be included in the LuxNUL league.</p>
Map	1:7,500, ISSOM-ish, 5 metre contours. Laser-printed, on Pretex semi-waterproof paper.
Terrain	Mostly flat residential urban streets, and some small paths. No hills! Torch or headlamp not necessary, the sun does not set until 20.15.
Safety	Everyone takes part entirely at their own risk. Please take great care, especially on or crossing the more major roads. Reflective or white clothing recommended.
After the run	Several bars nearby.
